ALL EXHIBITOR FEES: \$1.00 PER ENTRY TO A MAXIMUM OF 15 ENTRIES - FLAT \$20.00 FOR MORE THAN 15 ENTRIES

NO ENTRY FEE FOR SCHOOL ART OR COLORING CONTEST.

Rules & Regulations

Exhibitors are requested to carefully read all **Rules & Regulations** governing the Horticultural & Creative Craft Show.

- 1. Please list entries in the order shown in the Prize Book.** Every exhibitor **MUST** fill out a separate entry form. Extra entry forms and tags are available at the Two Hills Agricultural Society Office or may be downloaded from our website www.twohillsagsociety.com. Exhibit numbers can be picked up at the Two Hills Agricultural Society Office (phone 780-657-3542).
- 2. For each exhibit, a tag will be furnished to exhibitors. Exhibitors MUST CLEARLY AND CORRECTLY** specify entry number, article description, exhibitor number, printed name and mailing address. Tag must remain attached to the exhibit during the show. **NOTE: PeeWees and Teens/Juniors please include your age on your entry form.**
- 3. No exhibitor may show more than one entry per class. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor and have been made/grown within the last 12 months. Exhibits must be fresh and clean.**
- 4. An exhibitor may show an entry in an upper class provided it is not listed in their category. Example: a junior can show spinach under the teen category because it is not listed in the junior category. An exhibitor can only go up **one** level and must understand that their exhibit will be competing against others in**

the higher level. **This does not apply to photography. You can only display photos in your category.**

5. No person who has an entry will be allowed in the building while judging is being done. Society directors and volunteers are the exception.
6. Judges shall withhold awarding prize money where the exhibit is deemed not worthy, even if there is no competition: judges may award 2nd or 3rd prize when exhibit does not come up to the proper standards.
7. No money shall be paid out as a prize unless the exhibit has been offered in the prize list.
8. The Show Committee of Two Hills & District Agricultural Society reserves the right to decide on any point that is not covered by these rules & regulations.
9. ALLERGY ALERT! Baking is to have **NO NUTS OR PEANUT BUTTER** as ingredients.
10. All canning and baking exhibits must be homemade. No commercial mixes are acceptable.
11. All articles presented must be displayed as outlined, otherwise they will be disqualified. There will be no switching of articles to accommodate exhibitor's mistakes. Any prize incorrectly named or listed is not to be awarded a prize.
12. Prizes will be awarded in order 1st, 2nd, 3rd. Prize money will be awarded as indicated in prize book. There will be no ties (School Art is the exception).
13. Prize money will be mailed to the winners within 10 working days.
14. Any exhibitor lodging a protest must do so in writing and it must be delivered to a bench show committee member of the Two Hills & District Agricultural Society within 48 hours after the close of the fair, accompanied by a deposit of \$20.00 which will be forfeited to the Society if the protest is not substantiated.
14. While the Directors take every precaution under the circumstances to secure the safety of articles sent to the exhibition, the owners themselves must take the risk of exhibiting. Should any article be accidentally injured, lost or stolen, the Directors will give all the assistance in their power toward the recovery, but will not make payment for the value thereof.
15. Two copies of the Judging and Exhibiting Standards for Horticultural Shows are available at the Two Hills Ag Society Office. These copies are available for loan with a \$20.00 refundable deposit. Books can be loaned for a period of 1 week. Books can also be purchased from **Publications Office, Alberta**

16. Early removal of exhibits can occur between 2 and 3 pm on Sunday provided exhibitor leaves entry tags with the person releasing the exhibits. Early removal of any entries without leaving the entry tags behind will forfeit your rights to any discrepancies found. Tags will be returned with payment of awards.

17. If you wish to enter some of your exhibits at an earlier date (no sooner than the Thursday before the exhibit date) please contact any of the directors below to make arrangements.

18. The Alberta Weed Control Act has proclaimed Common Baby's-breath as a noxious weed. Common Baby's-breath ONLY will be accepted in the floral arrangements

19. All winning entries will be posted on the Two Hills Agricultural Society website. If you have any objection to having your name posted on this site, please indicate such by written notice. If written notice is not received, your entry form will indicate that you are in agreement of having your name posted.
