

Section 1: Fruits and Vegetables

Fruits

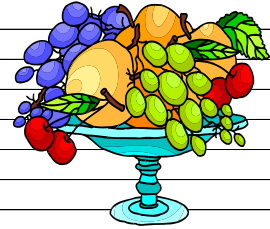
Prizes: 1st \$8.00; 2nd \$6.00; 3rd \$4.00

1. All horticulture exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor within the last 12 months.
2. All entries must be placed on **APPROPRIATE SIZE (small plate for small items) plain paper/foam plates**. Small items such as berries should be placed on a small plate and placed inside a ziploc bag. Bag will be removed during judging.
3. **Name variety whenever possible.**

All fruits will be judged according to quality, uniformity, condition, color, size and name.

1-1	Apples - 5 cm (2 in) and over	2	wiped clean, stems on
1-2	Apples - 5 cm (2 in) and under	2	wiped clean, stems on
1-3	Cherries, Nanking	8	include at least one fruit on a branch with 1 leaf
1-4	Saskatoons, Domestic	8	
1-5	Chokecherries, Native	8	fruits
1-6	Raspberries	6	with stems
1-7	Strawberries	6	with stems
1-8	Cherries, open	8	with stems
1-9	Fruit, other	2	wiped clean, stems on



Vegetables

Prizes: 1st \$8.00; 2nd \$6.00; 3rd \$4.00

1. Carrots, beets, and turnips must have tops cut off half [1/2] inch above crown and should be uniform in size.
2. Vegetables must be clean but not scrubbed and free of any blemishes.
3. Display on white paper plates **unless indicated by an asterisk(*)**
4. Name variety whenever possible.

Judging Criteria:

Color: Should be bright, clean and attractive. A rich dark color is preferred.

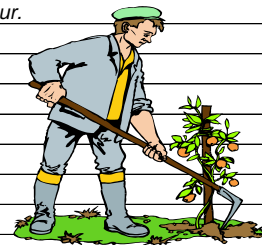
Condition: Free from blemishes that are caused by insects, disease, dirt or mechanical damage.

Size: Should be of moderate size. Usually oversized vegetables are coarse, tough and lacking in flavour.

Uniformity: All items in a display should be similar size, color, maturity and shape.

1-8	Beans, green	5	stems left on
1-9	Beans, purple	5	stems left on
1-10	Beets, cylinder	3	1 " stem left on
1-11	Broad Beans	3	named
1-12	Cabbage, green head	1	with 1-2 wrapper leaves
1-13	Carrots, under 5"	3	1 " stem left on
1-14	*Cucumber, English	1	over 10" with 1/2" Stems, Judged on shape and length
1-15	Cucumbers, pickling	3	with 1/2" Stems not over 3" long
1-16	Garlic, Rope	1	minimum of 8 garlic heads
1-17	Gourd	1	ornamental
1-18	Kohlrabi	2	with 4-6 centre leaves, root trimmed to 1/2 inch
1-19	Lettuce, head	1	1 plant with root cut off below bottom leaf
1-20	Onions, red	3	tops & roots trimmed (1/2"), peeled and cleaned
1-21	Onions, white - under 3"	3	tops & roots trimmed (1/2"), peeled and cleaned
1-22	Onions, yellow - over 3"	3	tops & roots trimmed (1/2"), peeled and cleaned
1-23	Parsley	1	bunch tied
1-24	Peas	6	pods on a plate, stems left on
1-25	Peppers, bell	2	with 1/2" stems
1-26	Peppers, other	2	with 1/2" stems
1-27	Potatoes, red	3	must be washed
1-28	Potatoes, white	3	must be washed
1-29	*Pumpkin, carved	1	1-2" stem attached



1-30	*Rhubarb	3	tied with 1" of leaves left on stalk Stalk intact as pulled, but cleaned
1-31	*Sunflower, head	1	not ornamental
1-32	Summer Turnip	2	tops trimmed 1/2" above crown
1-33	Swiss Chard	1	plant
1-34	Tomatoes, green, large	3	large with stems
1-35	Tomatoes, red, small	5	small variety
1-36	Tomatoes, Roma, red	3	with stem
1-37	*Zucchini, under 8"	1	with 1/2" stem.
1-38	Freaks or unusual
